Stir powdered soap and warm water together.

Mix everything together. Add blue food coloring.

Slowly pour the soap and water into the glue, stirring at the same time. Soon, the glacier goo will form. Add a few drops of food coloring. Squeeze and mix the glacier goo with your hands.
