

## VIDEO LESSON: GRIZZLY BEARS

### ANCHOR

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#### Activate Background Knowledge

SAY

*Today we are going to watch a video about bears. There are many types of bears that we can see all over the world. Before we watch the video let's look at some of the different types of bears and talk about where they might live.*

Print out several pictures of different types of bears, including grizzly, polar, brown, black, sun, and pandas. Discuss the different bears and where they might be found.

SAY

*Some of these bears can be found in zoos. Have you seen any of these bears in a zoo? What kind of bear would you want to see if you went to the zoo?*

Encourage students to share their experiences seeing bears at zoos or in national parks. Some students could even share videos they have seen about bears online or in class.

#### Purpose Statement

SAY

*In this video, we will learn more about one specific kind of bear, the Grizzly Bear! There are scientists that spend a lot of time learning all they can about bears. That's how we know so much about them. As you watch the video, ask yourself, "Would I like to learn more about bears? What other things would I like to learn about?"*

### WATCH

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#### After Watching the Video

SAY

*If you were going to tell your friend about the grizzly bear, what would you tell him or her? What do you want to learn more about?*

### APPLY

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SAY

*We watched a video about the Grizzly Bear. Let's look and think about what we learned and how we feel about bears. Look for details in the pictures to help you remember and tell your partner what you remember. Then talk about what you want to learn more about.*
