

VIDEO LESSON: *On Safari*

TOPIC | Identify the characteristics of a safari

OBJECTIVE | Identify details and engage in collaborative discussion related to the main idea of a video presentation.

ANCHOR

ACTIVATE BACKGROUND KNOWLEDGE

On the board or chart paper write, "**What did Jane see in the museum?**"



Today we are going to learn about a woman named Jane Goodall. Jane loved to learn, and she loved animals. She spent her life learning about chimpanzees. Jane loved learning so much that she would go to museums all the time. Let's read a little bit about Jane at a museum. As you listen try to answer the question, "What did Jane see in the museums?".

Read the following paragraph aloud.

At the Museum of Natural History, there were dinosaurs.

There were stuffed animals from Africa there, too.

In the National Gallery museum, there were beautiful works of art.

There were paintings by famous artists like Vincent Van Gogh.

In the British Museum, there were mummies from ancient Egypt!

Point to and read the question, "**What did Jane see in the museums?**".

Pause for student responses and write them on the board or chart paper.

What did Jane see in the museums?

Possible responses:

- Dinosaurs
- Beautiful works of art
- Paintings by Vincent Van Gogh
- Mummies from Egypt

PURPOSE STATEMENT
